SAT/ACT Tutoring Plan

- Students review any previous scores by logging into their College Board account and reviewing the actual test questions and providing tips and strategies during the review
- Students complete a full-length practice test from The Official SAT Study Guide
- Students score and review tips and strategies after completing the practice test
- All subsequent sessions include taking practice sections from the SAT book and working on recognizing test questions, applying strategies, developing skills, and practicing timing techniques
- Students complete two additional full-length practice tests over the next 8 one-hour sessions
- Most students complete 8 to 12 sessions prior to the PSAT or SAT, depending on the amount of time available
